Leading the JAVA Executive Council is newly elected president, Lieutenant Colonel (LTC) Allen Goshi, USA-Ret. LTC Mark Nakagawa, USA-Ret and COL George Ishikata, USA-Ret were re-elected to be vice president and treasurer, respectively. CPT Wade Ishimoto, USA-Ret, and former president and vice president was elected to be secretary.

After thanking past president Mike Cardarelli and the leadership team for their work of the past few years, Goshi said "I have three commitments to our membership: 1) Dedicate myself to faithfully and diligently serve JAVA and its members; 2) Move forward and communicate with members as we conduct business; and 3) Collaboratively develop an assessment of our situation, a strategic plan aligned with JAVA's purpose, and follow through on that vision.".
