(A collateral descendent is defined as an applicant who is a direct descendent of a brother, sister, uncle, aunt, nephew, or niece of a World War II Nisei military service member. **OR**
 I am a current member of [JAVA](https://java.wildapricot.org), <https://java.wildapricot.org>, whose membership began prior to April 1, 2018. **OR**
 I am the child of a current [JAVA](https://java.wildapricot.org) member[†]. My parent / guardian is a member of JAVA whose membership began prior to April 1, 2018.
